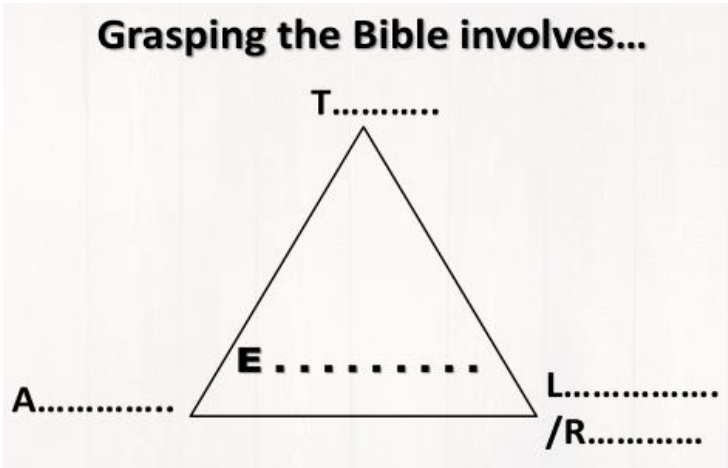

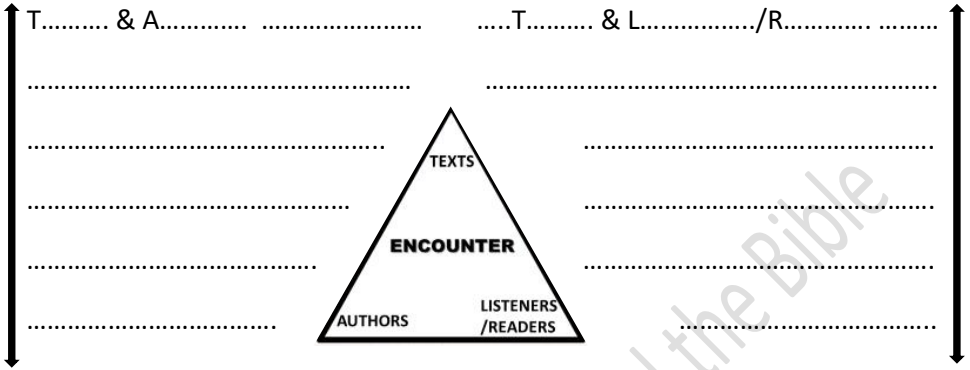

St. Matthew ch. 9 vs 18-26

Jesus raises a dead girl and heals a sick woman

(HEADING: supplied by New International Version editors)

9¹⁸ While he was saying this, [just then] a synagogue leader came and knelt before him and said, 'My daughter has just died. But come and put your hand on her, and she will live.'¹⁹ Jesus got up and went with him, and so did his disciples.

²⁰ Just then a woman who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years came up behind him and touched the edge of his cloak.²¹ She said to herself, 'If I only touch his cloak, I will be healed.'²² Jesus turned and saw her. 'Take heart, daughter,' he said, 'your faith has healed you.' And the woman was healed at that moment.

²³ When Jesus entered the synagogue leader's house and saw the noisy crowd and the people playing pipes,²⁴ he said, 'Go away. The girl is not dead but asleep.' But they laughed at him.²⁵ After the crowd had been put outside, he went in and took the girl by the hand, and she got up.²⁶ News of this spread through all that region.
